

CALL FOR PAPERS AND AWARDS COMPETITION

BRAZILIAN SOCIETY OF CELL THERAPY AND REGENERATIVE MEDICINE - SOBRACEL

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF SCIENTIFIC PAPERS AND AWARDS COMPETITION

- 1) Only active members of SOBRACEL may submit scientific papers and participate in the awards competition of the 2nd SOBRACEL International Congress.
- 2) Papers must be submitted through the SOBRACEL website at www.sobracel.org.br or through the link <https://beacons.ai/sobraceloficial>. **Deadline for paper submission: May 15, 2026.**
- 3) The author who submits the paper will automatically be the author and presenter if the paper is selected. A maximum of two papers per author are allowed.
- 4) The author/presenter's academic title defines the award category for which the work is competing, and this must be indicated in the specific item on the registration form.
- 5) In addition to the author/presenter, up to five co-authors may be included. Names should not be abbreviated.
- 6) Indicate the institution where the work was carried out.
- 7) Indicate the category of registration of the work: undergraduate student, graduate student, professional researcher.
- 8) Indicate the desired presentation format: ORAL or E-POSTER.
- 9) Report any conflict of interest, if applicable. In the specific field, indicate: "CONFLICT OF INTEREST: company name and its product"
- 10) The work must be submitted as a structured abstract (introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion).
- 11) The structured abstract has a limit of 500 words and may contain up to 5 figures, which must be cited in the body of the work and presented with captions and numbering. The abstract must have bibliographic references cited throughout the text, which must be numbered in superscript. A complete and numbered list of references must be presented at the end of the abstract. The list of references is not part of the word limit for the abstract. The abstract must be written in Arial 12 font and double-spaced. The abstract must be submitted as a PDF file, uploaded via the registration form.



12) By registering and presenting their work, authors automatically authorize its online or printed publication in the Congress Proceedings.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1) The author of the work will automatically be the presenter, and all information regarding the selection of the work, its acceptance or rejection, and presentation guidelines will be sent to them via the registered email address.

2) The author/presenter must be registered for the Congress to present and participate in the awards competition.

3) If the registered author/presenter cannot attend the Congress, they must provide the name of the co-author registered in the work who will replace them. This co-author must be registered for the congress and will become the author/presenter of the work on the congress certificate and awards.

4) SOBRACEL does not issue individual authorship certificates for co-authors not registered for the Congress; these co-authors participate in a certificate listed as a group of co-authors.

5) Certificates will be available after the event ends.

6) Presentation during the Congress:

- E-poster display: e-posters must be displayed throughout the congress, and media must be available from the beginning of the congress. The date and time of presentation will be at the discretion of the SOBRACEL Awards Committee and cannot be chosen or changed by the author.
- Oral presentation: the date and time of presentation will be at the discretion of the SOBRACEL Awards Committee and cannot be chosen or changed by the author.

7) The use of patient photos/videos will be the sole responsibility of the author.

8) The criteria for selecting papers are the importance and significance of the themes for the BRAZILIAN SOCIETY OF CELL THERAPY AND REGENERATIVE MEDICINE – SOBRACEL, and for awards the criteria are originality, relevance, methods, results, discussion, and conclusions.
